Subject:- Grant of yearly permission to Al-Ameen Unani Medical College, Sayne Khurd, Gat No. 92/1, Dhule Road, Malegaon-423203, Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra (Inst. Id.:- UNI0561) with 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg

Sir/Madam,

- 1) To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Al-Ameen Unani Medical College, Sayne Khurd, Gat No. 92/1, Dhule Road, Malegaon-423203, Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra (Inst. Id.:- UNI0561)** inspection was conducted on **22.05.2025** or **23.05.2025**, as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the permission with 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020-reg.**
- 2) The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Unani colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2023", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects were observed:-**
 1. **List of Teaching departments:-**
 - a) Both Computer and printer are not available in Medical Superintendent office.
 2. **Central Library:-**
 - a) There is shortage of 327 books against the minimum requirement of 7500 books.
 - b) There is shortage of 25 sitting capacity against the minimum requirement of 50.
 3. **Herbal Garden:-**
 - a) There is shortage of 25 species against the minimum requirement of 150 species.
 4. **Teaching Pharmacy:-**
 - a) Quality testing lab is not available.
 5. **Biometric attendance**
 - a) Aadhar enabled Biometric attendance System to track attendance is not available for the non-teaching staff and Hospital Staff.
 6. **Teaching staffs:-**
 - a) No Arabic teacher is available.
 - b) Availability of total teaching staff for UG (BUMS) Course as per the part 1 submitted by the college is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{28}{30} \times 100\% = 93.33\%$ (Excluding Excess).

10. **Mean** of general OR essential equipment's/instruments is 94.75%.

- 3) The assessment report has been carefully examined in terms concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and as per the direction of competent authority the assessment report was placed in the **134th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **16.07.2025** and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the requisite criteria for issuance of permission in UG (BUMS) Course as per the Concerned Acts and regulations. However, Board decided to issue yearly permission in accordance with policy letter dated 23.01.2025 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2025-26.

"DECISION"

- 4) Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above Yearly Permission is hereby granted to Al-Ameen Unani Medical College, Sayne Khurd, Gat No. 92/1, Dhule Road, Malegaon-423203, Dist. Nashik, Maharashtra (Inst. Id.:- UNI0561) in accordance with Regulation 16 (2) & (3) (h) of MESAR UG Unani 2023 and as per the Policy letter dated 23.01.2025 with 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-

I. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BUMS) course** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

5) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.

6) Further, as per **Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of **Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020** the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

7) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

8) Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters with vide ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.

9) The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB-ISM by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-

- i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled.
- ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Unani colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2023.
- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) **The remaining shortcomings mentioned in Para no. 2, shall be fulfilled.**

10) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
